Happy Easter!!!

Alleluia, He is risen!!! I imagine that, as we celebrate the resurrection of Christ, this easter, we cannot but take our minds back this time last year 2020. The initial goal was “two weeks to flatten the curve”, and there were debates about whether, we will be celebrating Easter the usual ways we have done for years. Priests and pastors beginning with Palm Sunday were basically experimenting with a variety of options to engage parishioners during the most important celebration in our faith. But no matter how innovative those ideas were there was no way they could replace the joy of the faith community worshipping together.

“Christ will raise us up ‘on the last day’; but it is also true that, in a certain way, we have already risen with Christ. For, by virtue of the Holy Spirit, Christian life is already now on earth a participation in the death and Resurrection of Christ: And you were buried with him in Baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead . . . If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. (CCC, 1002)

“United with Christ by Baptism, believers already truly participate in the heavenly life of the risen Christ, but this life remains ‘hidden with Christ in God.’ The Father has already ‘raised us up with him, and made us sit with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.’ Nourished with his body in the Eucharist, we already belong to the Body of Christ. When we rise on the last day we ‘also will appear with him in glory.’”(CCC, 1003)


