

Dear Sisters and Brothers,



The Word, the Bread, His Flesh

Having grossly failed to see the signs and appreciate who Jesus really is, he takes very unequivocal steps using scripture to try convincing the crowds. As we will continue to see in the following weeks in the same chapter of John's gospel, it is going to be a long day for Jesus in this endeavor of establishing his identity as the One who has come down from heaven. Accepted or not by the crowds, Jesus knows exactly what he is talking about – He came as the bread of life to save and feed us.

“For a Christian, believing in God cannot be separated from believing in the One he sent, his ‘beloved Son’, in whom the Father is ‘well pleased’; God tells us to listen to him. The Lord himself said to his disciples: ‘Believe in God, believe also in me.’ We can believe in Jesus Christ because he is himself God, the Word made flesh: ‘No one has ever seen God; the only Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, he has made him known.’ Because he ‘has seen the Father’, Jesus Christ is the only one who knows him and can reveal him. (CCC, 151)

“The Gospels report that at two solemn moments, the Baptism and the Transfiguration of Christ, the voice of the Father designates Jesus his ‘beloved Son’. Jesus calls himself the ‘only Son of God’, and by this title affirms his eternal pre-existence. He asks for faith in ‘the name of the only Son of God’. In the centurion's exclamation before the crucified Christ, ‘Truly this man was the Son of God’, that Christian confession is already heard. Only in the Paschal mystery can the believer give the title "Son of God" its full meaning. (CCC, 444)

“The Word became flesh so that thus we might know God's love: ‘In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him.’ ‘For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.’ (CCC, 458)

It is the “Word became flesh”, the crowds are strongly enjoined to partake in to have eternal life. Do we deeply grasped what this means when receive the Holy Eucharist?


