THREE IN ONE

Dear Sisters and Brothers,



Trinity of Love

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, the mystery of God, is that of love. How we need that love in the times we live in! As John puts it in that famous passage, “God is love, and whoever remains in love remains in God and God in him.” (1 Jn. 4.16) While we call on God in our prayers every day, today we are once again invited to delve deeper into the life and relationship of the Trinity. We are called to communion following the example of the three persons of the Blessed Trinity.

“The Church is one because of her source: ‘the highest exemplar and source of this mystery is the unity, in the Trinity of Persons, of one God, the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit.’ The Church is one because of her founder: for ‘the Word made flesh, the prince of peace, reconciled all men to God by the cross, . . . restoring the unity of all in one people and one body.’ The Church is one because of her ‘soul’: ‘It is the Holy Spirit, dwelling in those who believe and pervading and ruling over the entire Church, who brings about that wonderful communion of the faithful and joins them together so intimately in Christ that he is the principle of the Church’s unity.’ Unity is of the essence of the Church: ‘What an astonishing mystery! There is one Father of the universe, one Logos of the universe, and also one Holy Spirit, everywhere one and the same; there is also one virgin become mother, and I should like to call her “Church.’ (CCC, 813)

“From the beginning, this one Church has been marked by a great diversity which comes from both the variety of God’s gifts and the diversity of those who receive them. Within the unity of the People of God, a multiplicity of peoples and cultures is gathered together. Among the Church’s members, there are different gifts, offices, conditions, and ways of life. ‘Holding a rightful place in the communion of the Church there are also particular Churches that retain their own traditions.’ The great richness of such diversity is not opposed to the Church’s unity. Yet sin and the burden of its consequences constantly threaten the gift of unity. And so the Apostle has to exhort Christians to ‘maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.’” (CCC, 814)

While we are definitely not perfect in our love of and communion with one another, our faith communities can still be a beckon of leadership in building a more cohesive society. The more we reflect the values of love, peace and unity in our day to day interactions, the more we can engender same in society.

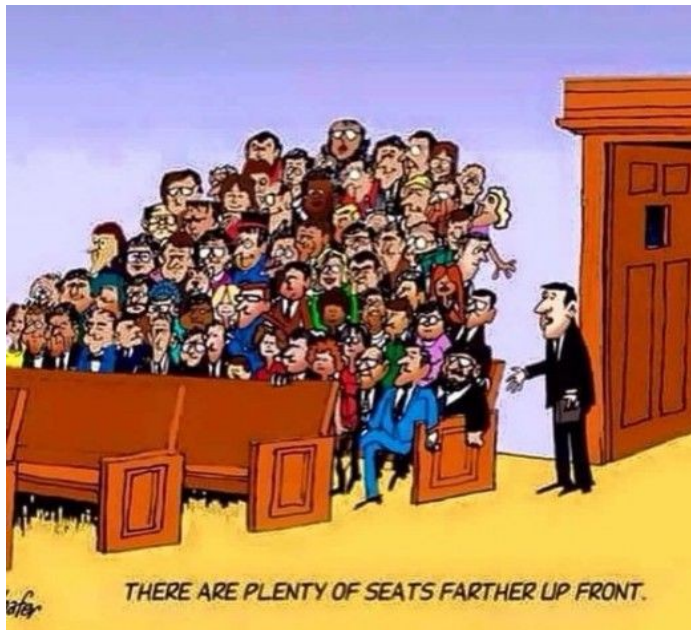
