Praying for the Shepherd

At every mass that we celebrate, the local ordinary, the bishop of the diocese is specifically mentioned and prayed for in the eucharistic prayer. The same is true of our new bishop, Most Rev. Erik Pohlmeier. As he begins his episcopal ministry, it is auspicious that, in our readings for today's liturgy prayer takes a center stage and intercessory prayer as well. Let us in a special way this Sunday lift up our diocesan shepherd in prayer that his mission will be fruitful for the people of God entrusted to his pastoral care.

Praying and interceding for others is to imitate our father in faith, Abraham. His example in today's first reading reminds us of the charity to continue to do so for all who count on the generosity of our prayers for them. Indeed, there are many who need and request our prayers every day.

“Intercession is a prayer of petition which leads us to pray as Jesus did. He is the one intercessor with the Father on behalf of all men, especially sinners. He is ‘able for all time to save those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.’ The Holy Spirit ‘himself intercedes for us . . . and intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.’ (CCC, 2634)

“Since Abraham, intercession - asking on behalf of another has been characteristic of a heart attuned to God's mercy. In the age of the Church, Christian intercession participates in Christ's, as an expression of the communion of saints. In intercession, he who prays looks ‘not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others,’ even to the point of praying for those who do him harm. (CCC, 2635)

“The first Christian communities lived this form of fellowship intensely. Thus the Apostle Paul gives them a share in his ministry of preaching the Gospel but also intercedes for them. The intercession of Christians recognizes no boundaries: ‘for all men, for kings and all who are in high positions,’ for persecutors, for the salvation of those who reject the Gospel. (CCC, 2636)

May the good Lord prosper the works of our new Bishop!

Christ is Present



"All of us realize that there is more than one way in which Christ is present in His Church. We want to go into this very joyful subject, which the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy presented briefly, at somewhat greater length. Christ is present in His Church when she prays, since He is the one who "prays for us and prays in us and to whom we pray: He prays for us as our priest, He prays in us as our head, He is prayed to by us as our God"; and He is the one who has promised, "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, I am there in the midst of them." (MF 35)
