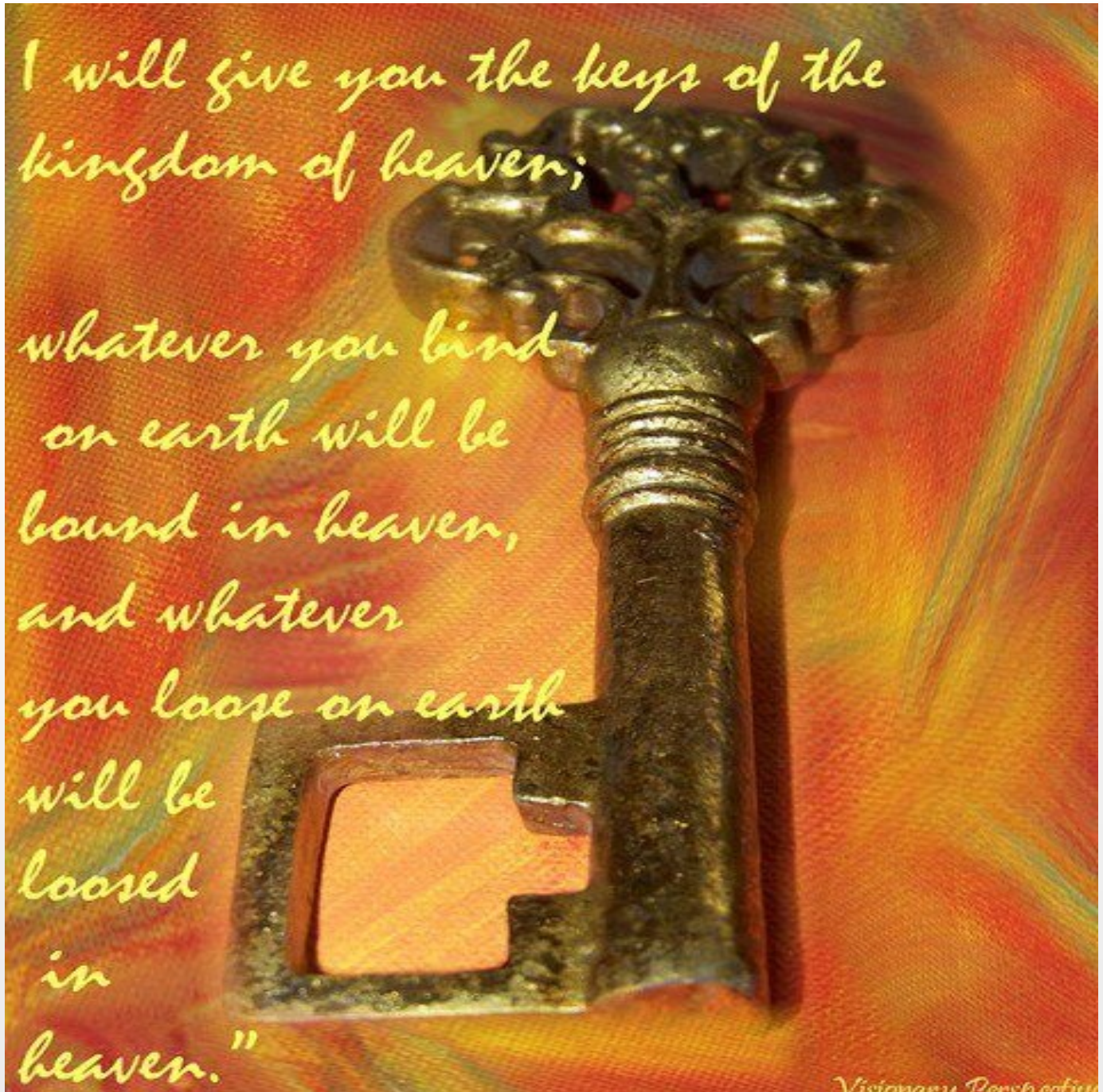

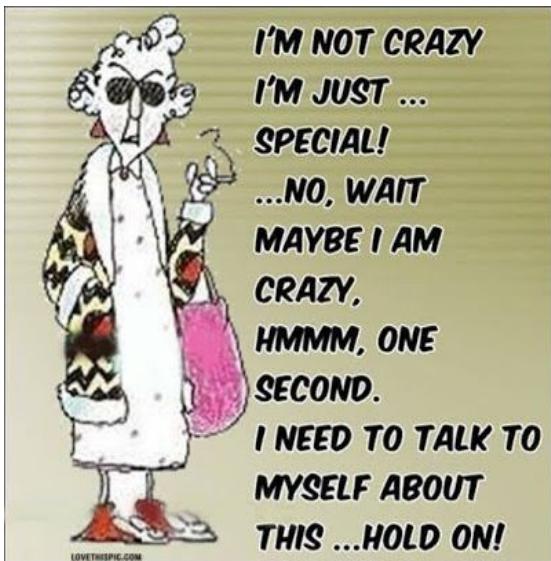

Coffee & Sweets are served in the cafeteria following the 11:30 mass. Join others in fellowship.

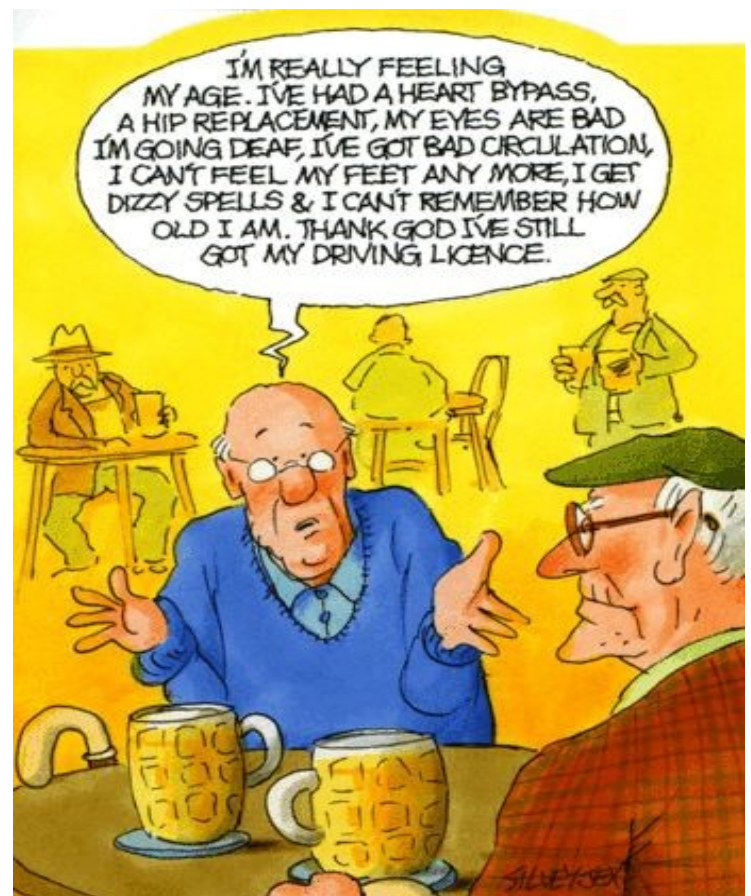
What Do You Say?
